I. CALL TO ORDER Lois Bernstein

II. STUDENT LEARNING Marissa Schlesinger & Amunoo Tembo

- VP Schlesinger provided an introduction and overview of TCC's campuses. She also provided an overview of the instruction programs within the Women's correctional facilities as TCC is the sole educational provider of Washington's women correctional facilities.
- The presentation will include information on the assessment cycle, the Degree Learning Outcomes (DLO) assessment, look at the future of assessment at TCC, and look at a snap shot of student success in our prof. tech. programs specifically through an equity lens.
- Assessment Cycle at TCC allows us to understand how our students are progressing through their courses beyond grades. The information gives us understanding from the course level, up to the program/specialization, and then ultimately up to the degree level. To review all of this data we break it down into a cycle.
 - One change we are working on is to identify what our specific program/specialization outcomes are within the degrees. This is in connection with our Guided Pathways work and hope to implement next year.
 - Our new focus within course learning outcomes are reviewing them for equity mindedness.
- TCC has six Degree Learning Outcomes. These are assessed on a three-year cycle. The three assessed this last year are Responsibility & Ethics, Critical Thinking & Problem Solving, and Intercultural Collaboration & Diversity.
- Assessment Methods use rubrics to score the sample artifacts that faculty have provided. eLearning supports this work by providing all of the student artifacts presented by faculty so that the committee can review them. The committee is

comprised of individuals from all disciplines across campus.

- VP Schlesinger and Amunoo were unable to cover the data from this year's assessment and will review this information for the Trustees at another time.
