

Dear Campus Community,

At TCC, we value inclusivity and the diversity of our wonderful college community. We share a goal to foster an environment that supports mutual respect, teamwork and freedom of expression.

Our values have recently been tested as racism, discrimination and xenophobic attacks against the Asian and Pacific Islander community have escalated since the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic began. We must stand up and not tolerate such behavior. As president of TCC, it is my responsibility to uphold the values of our college. I can assure you that TCC will not tolerate any racist behavior whether online, in-person, or via any other means that is directed at any racial group, but in particular of those in the Asian and Pacific Islander community.

Pandemics have been with us for thousands of years and have come from many different countries for many different reasons. COVID-19 may have originated in China, but the Chinese are not responsible for creating it. No one created this virus. It came from nature. Historians and public health experts and groups have advised not to assign names or geographic locations to infectious diseases. Such association leads to discrimination and xenophobia.

Although we are not aware of any racist incidents on our campus, there have been incidents targeting the Asian and Pacific Islander community in the area, including hate speech, vandalism and assault. Several of our own TCC members have faced racist and aggressive behaviors in public spaces. We have heard of other incidents, such as microaggressions, against Asians and Pacific Islanders. None of these type of behaviors are acceptable.
